This promotional CD sampler showcases the immense talent that the East Coast offers. This CD will continue to build upon the goals of Music & Image program by exposing Atlantic Canadian artists to new opportunities in the film, television and new media sectors.

The Music & Image Compilation CD will be distributed to key industry players, in both the national and international marketplace, including 1000 delegates at the 29th Atlantic Film Festival and approximately 2000 delegates at the 2010 East coast Music Awards, Festival & Conference.

APPLICANT CRITERIA

1. Open to all genres of music
2. Artist(s) must have released at least one professional manufactured CD
3. Artist(s) must own and control master (track/song usage)
4. Artist(s) must control publishing
5. Artist(s) must have professional press kit/bio/EPK/web presence

*Previous music placement experience in film, television and new media is an asset

*Artists selected for the CD will be contact and required to provide a high quality WAV file version of their track. Licensing Agreement will be issued outlining the terms and conditions of this recording. Please note, this CD Compilation is for promotional use only and is not for resale.

- One song/track in MP3 or Audio CD format. If submitting on CD please clearly indicate which track (if applicable) is to be considered for selection
- Selected song title/CD title/length of song
- Contact information (name, management representatives, mailing address, telephone, email and website)
- 50 word biography on artist/group
- Short description of song including full song lyrics
