This crash course in filmmaking will provide students with the fundamentals of visual storytelling and Super 8 filmmaking. Participants will first learn the basics of camera operation and how film works as well as receive tips on how to illustrate their story on film. In four groups of three to five people each and a team leader, students will then have the chance to write, storyboard and shoot their own silent, three-minute Super 8 film in just two days!

The top 10, based on feasibility and originality, will be selected to participate in the pitching workshop with Jan Miller. 24 hours later three projects will be selected for production to premiere at the 29th Atlantic Film Festival in September 2009!
